ANNOUNCEMENT

The scientific society Centro Italiano per la Ricerca Storico-Educativa (CIRSE) announces the third edition of “Rivista di Storia dell'educazione Award” for the year 2024. Awardees can be its members and associates, as well as scholars of educational history not active in Italy, who can participate without a CIRSE membership.

The following publications are eligible for the Award:

- Articles in a language other than Italian published in a scholarly journal in 2021, 2022 or 2023;
- Book chapters in a language other than Italian, where the book belongs to a refereed series, published in 2021, 2022 or 2023.

Authors should send a copy of their article or book chapter in PDF format no later than March 10th, 2024, to the following e-mail address: segreteria@cirse.it.

The application must contain:

- name and surname, mail, phone and e-mail contact details of the participant;
- title of the publication, accompanied by a brief presentation of the article or book chapter;
- proof of payment of participation fee of € 30.00 (thirty euros) to bank account n. 000401267537, Banca Unicredit – Agenzia di Firenze Sansovino (03519) – IBAN: IT 50 B 02008 02845 000401267537; BIC/SWIFT: UNCRITM1RN9 –, addressed to: CENTRO ITALIANO PER LA RICERCA STORICO EDUCATIVA CIRSE; Reason for payment: Premio Rivista di Storia dell'educazione anno 2024.

Payment is due by March 7th, 2024.

Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in exclusion from the Award.

The President, Cirse Executive Board members, and Cirse Award winners in the previous three years are not eligible to compete for the Award.

The works received will be examined by unquestionable criteria, which cannot be challenged in any forum. The Commission will award a maximum of 2 (two) articles with the “Rivista di Storia dell'educazione 2024 Award”, consisting of a certificate.

The Award Judging Committee includes the CIRSE Presidential Council (President, vice-president, and secretary) and the Board of Arbitrators, provided with due competence in the MPED/02 sector (History of Education). Each member of the Commission will have n. 1 (one) vote for each category of the Award; in case of a tie, the vote of the President will prevail. The Secretary of the Commission will take appropriate minutes of its meetings.

Winners will be notified via e-mail by April 18th, 2024.

The names of the winners and judgments on the awarded works will be published on the society's official website (www.cirse.it) and other media deemed appropriate.
